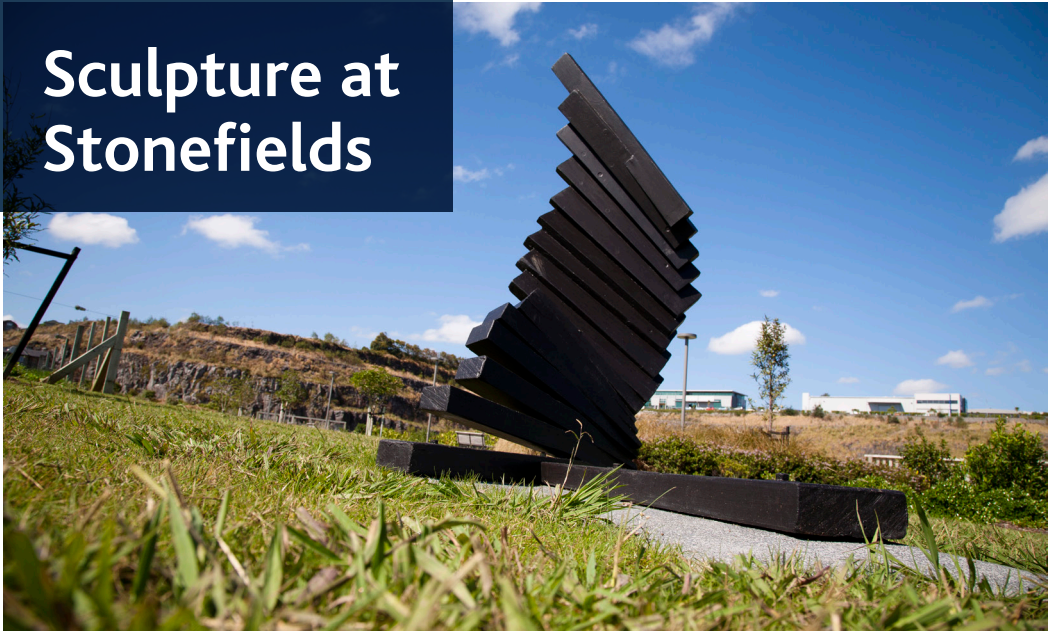


# Sculpture at Stonefields
